## **Staff Changes**

Good morning everyone,

Fall is here and the Lord's handiwork can be seen in the vibrant colors of the changing leaves. What an awesome God we have, knowing he is in control of everything!

Over the past few weeks Mrs. Fischer and I have been talking with the teaching staff in the PreK3 and Kindergarten classrooms. We have concluded that we could unitize the gifts and talents of these teachers by having Miss Yotter teach in the Kindergarten room and Miss Hofland teach in the PreK 3 room. This change would be very

beneficial to both the students in the classroom as well as the ministry of St. John's. The results of our discussion were brought to the Board of Education on Monday, October 10th. The board approved the recommendation and the Chairman took it to the Administrative Board on Oct. 11th. The board approved the recommendation also, and the President of the congregation will take the recommendation to the voters meeting on Tuesday, Oct 18th, for their approval as well.

If the congregation approves the recommendation, the two teachers will end their responsibilities in their current classrooms after school on October 20th. Beginning on October 24th Miss Hofland will be the teacher in the PreK 3 classroom and Miss Yotter will be teacher in the Kindergarten classroom.

We see the Lord's hand in all of this, and the staff will work closely with each of the teachers to make this move as seamless as possible.
